

## STUDENT INFORMATION 2025

### Homework

- Homework must be turned in in person. Do not email it or send it in a text.
- Homework should be hand-written, unless otherwise specified. Your name in the top, left corner. The assignment name on the top line
- Your writing must be legible. No micro-writing ( $\frac{3}{16}$ " or 5mm, minimum height). Use standard number forms. *1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 0*
- All homework must be turned by the beginning of class on test review day. I will not take it after that.
- Don't use Google, Alexa, Siri, AI, etc. to answer the questions. Homework teaches you reading comprehension and analytical skills. Do the homework. Do the homework. Do the homework. Be smart. Use your brain. Learn things. The point of doing homework is practicing and developing skills, not just turning in a list of correct answers.

### Tests

- No phones out during a test. If your phone is out, you get an automatic zero on the test.
- If you start a test, you have to finish it at that time.
- Go to the restroom before starting a test. You can't take breaks in the middle of a test.
- If you miss a test, you have one week after you return to class to make up the test.

### Test Corrections

- The best way to raise your grades is to do test corrections. You can earn back half of the points that were deducted. You have to make a 40 or higher on a test in order to do corrections.
- Write test corrections on notebook paper. Do not change your answers on the test. Show all the work for problems that involve math. Staple your corrections to the front of the test and turn it in before the deadline.
- Math test corrections will be done together in class.
- Test corrections are processed only four times during the year: Thanksgiving break, Christmas break, Spring break, and the first week in May.

### Friday Tutoring

On most Fridays, I have one-on-one tutoring from 2:00– 5:00 pm at my house. You can drop by to work on homework or test corrections.

### High School Honors/AP Classes

Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Anatomy, Calculus, and Literature can be taken as honors classes. Honors students do more work and are better prepared for college. Honors classes can count for more points than regular classes.

### WiFi Password

### Attendance

Classes meet in person. If you cannot attend class in person, you can attend on Google Meet. If you cannot attend on Meet, watch the class video after it is posted. Assignments are still due at their regular time, even if you do not attend in person.

### Using Google Meet

If you want to attend on Google Meet, you or your parent need to send me a text before class that day, or you can send me an email the day before. I will create a link for you to use.

## Gradebook

I usually update the grades on the weekend. The best time for you to check your grades is Monday morning.  
I do not use the colored dot system on the app; please ignore the dots/snowflakes.

*Missing* = If it says “missing” in red, it was not turned in when it was due, but you can still turn it in.

*Late* = You turned in the last homework assignment on the day of the test. Late homework will be graded at the end of the semester.

*Blank* = It was not turned in before the test review and there is no grade.

“No grade” is not a zero. It does not bring your average down. You are allowed two “no grade” homework grades each semester. After that, missing homework will be given a zero.
