Extra Info: Two months after Pearl Harbor, a Japanese submarine launched 16 shells at Ellwood Beach in California. Only minor damage occurred. On June 21, 1942, a Japanese sub shot 17 shells at a military fort on the coast of Oregon. In September, the same sub returned and launched a floatplane with two fire bombs. They tried to start a forest fire, but it was quickly put out.

The Japanese Army massacred 200,000 to 300,000 civilians in Nanking, China before the beginning of World War 2. They were known to be brutal and merciless. They even killed women and children.
